Following our experiences on this remote crescent-shaped island, we visit Prince Edward Island, then continue to the red sandstone cliffs of Les Iles-de-la-Madeleine, Quebec's Gaspé Peninsula, Anticosti Island, the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Gros Morn (NFLD), Francois (outport community NFLD) and our foray into France's petite enclave of St. Pierre et Miquelon.

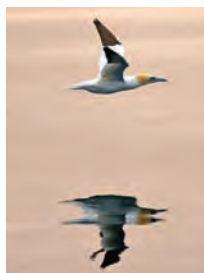
THIS VOYAGE IS TRULY A WILDLIFE ADVENTURE.

- Admission on embarkation day to the must-visit Fortress of Louisbourg, a National Historical Site of Canada.



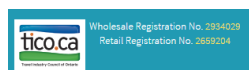
